What to expect when you purchase a boat.

When you participate in the bidding process and your bid is successful, you immediately become the new owner as soon as teh auctioneer's hammer falls and the "Sold" announcement is made.

Payment: You are required to pay 10% of the sale price for the boat on the day of the sale.

The buyer is responsible for the balance of the payment within 48 hours after the completion of the boat show. When the purchase, payment and processing is complete, keys to the boat will be released to the buyer. Antique Boat America.com gate staff will verify the buyers dopy of the bill of sale before the boat is allowed to be removed for the auction site. Boats must be removed form the auction site no later than 72 hours following the completion of the sale
